this passage or segment, and by seeing it we learn to trust Him. Then, trusting in His strength, we are able to give ourselves to the work. This learning is accomplished by believing what God has said and seeing what God has done.

III. Conclusion: I know that learning to trust is a progressive affair and may go slowly. Mueller's thought was that he learned to trust God for a penny and then in time could trust him with pounds (English money!) God did not ask them to build the temple magically or in five days. He simply wanted them to start and trust Him for each day and the Divine assurance was that they could complete the job and He would be honored thereby.

Biblical Passages: Zechariah 3
