answer is simple. It is the most elemental expression of the will of God and thereby the most necessary thing for us to know.

Without the law of God, Israel would have been just another name in the history of nations. But God's law was His presence and it was God with the nation that gave her force and existence. Israel would not have been, without the Lord, and without His law the people would have known mothing of Him. But with the law there was strength and when Israel turned in faith to God she was blessed. But this law revealed God to His people and belief in it was belief in Him.

So with Jesus. Belief in Him is belief in God. Without Him nothing can be achieved while in Him all things are possible. To ognore Him is to reject the law of God but to believe in the law is to believe in Him. It is unfortunate that some feel Jesus is contrary to the law. As a perfect man He kept it with honor. Those who honor the law honor him. But you will discover that those who do not honor Him soon dishonor the law as well.

God gave His people a law and a Saviour. Belief in both is what proves them to be the people of God not only in claim but also in the reality of life.
