c. the measuring line 4:1-5
 Jerusalem is to be rebuilt - it will be too great to measure. The Lord will carry

- d. the cleaving of Joshua 3:1-10
- the custom with Satan 1
 - Joshua's clothes 3
 - his cleaving 4-5
 - his charge 7-10

(We have the land, the Lord's presence, the ordained priest - what now is needed)

e. the Great Burnt Offering 4:1-14

- the lamp (symbolism = light = spirit)
- the charge to Zebadiah
- and a mystery that should inspire confidence, but...

f. The fly's roll 5:1-4

- the description (the two sides: why: Rev 4)
- these are the deprecations most harmful -
- condemnation of the deprecations.

g. The Eph 5:5-11

- the symbolic elements
- let the things of Babylon be sent to Babylon

h. the four chariots: The time for decisive action has come... Build the Temple!
