גֵּיא "valley" (גֵּיא)
וּמַשׁ "move" (מִשׁ)

The earthquake of Uzziah's time is also noted in the book of Amos. The action of flight regards the haste, not necessarily the direction. Note the ending of the passage..."the Lord and his saints."

יִקְרוּב "rare" "precious"

14:7...

A verse describing a confused period of life out of several reasons.

14:8...

חֲצִי "half"
בַּחֲדָף "winter"
בִּקְיָץ "summer"

14:9...

Note the rule of God. This is certainly more than a rule of God in the hearts of believers.

14:10...

כְּעֵרְבָה "like a plain"

A powerful verse regarding the reclamation and restoration of the land.

14:11...

חֲרָם "utter destruction"

A scene of peaceful dwelling
