

## Colossians -2

4. The student will specialize in some passage or theme of Colossians in researching and writing a term paper.
5. A careful weekly reading of the book will be required of all students. Those seeking credit for Greek will be required to translate the book.

### PROCEDURES

1. Assigned research projects into the historical data underlying the book will be evaluated and graded.
2. Translation and reading work will be evaluated as will class discussion and response.
3. The term paper will be graded for quality of work, in research, original thought, preparation and mechanics.
4. A final examination will determine the student's knowledge of the facts discussed in class and the content of the letter to the Colossians.
