

3. Procedural notes:

We have now finished the introduction to the course and the summary notes on the periods. In the remainder of this syllabus we will follow the procedures given:

We move period by period

At the start of each period we will have a chart indicating the major factors of interest in the period.

We will have some general notation of what was produced in the period and then to attempt to understand why this was produced we will research the background of the period.

To help the student keep up with us on this matter I am resorting to a "colored paper" device. The chart and the notations of dogma as produced will be on colored paper. Background and explanatory stuff will be on white as have these notes so far.

I am sorry it takes so long to get a course like this under way. But the definitions, explanation of character, and the notations on the periods are all very important. They need not be memorized of course, but they must be understood.
