וְאָהַבְתָּ

1. וְאָהַבְתָּ אֶת יְיָ אֱלֹהֶיךָ,
 And you shall love the Lord your
 God, with all your heart
 and with all your soul,
 2. וְבְכָל מְאֹדְךָ.
 And with all your might.
3. וְהָיוּ הַדְּבָרִים הָאֵלֶּה,
 And these words,
 4. אֲשֶׁר אֲנֹכִי מְצַוֶּה הַיּוֹם,
 Which I command you this day,
 shall be upon your heart.
 5. וְשִׁנַּנְתֶּם לְבַנְיֵה,
 And you shall teach them unto
 your children, and shall talk
 about them,
 6. וְדַבַּרְתֶּם בָּם,
 When you sit in your house, and
 when you walk on the road,
 7. וּבְשֹׁכְבְךָ וּבְקוּמְךָ.
 And when you lie down, and when
 you rise up.
 8. וְקָשַׁרְתֶּם לָאוֹת עַל יָדְךָ,
 And you shall bind them for a
 sign upon your hand,
 9. וְהָיוּ לְטַטְפַּת בֵּין עֵינֶיךָ.
 And they shall be as a reminder
 between your eyes.
