

2. ךָ "you, yours" (masc) כֶּם "you, yours" (m)
 ךְ "you, yours" (fem) כֶּן "you, yours (f.)"
3. (הוּא) "his, him" (הֵם) "their, them" m.
 (הִיא) "her" (הֵנָּה) "their, them" f.

These are also definite and consequently make the word attached definite. You will see them with nouns, adjectives, etc. The class that goes with verbs has a lot of similarity!

3. Verbal Pronoun suffixes..they are added to verb forms!

There are a number of wrinkles with these but don't be alarmed. Following are some examples taken from page 21. Look them up in that text and be sure you understand each one mentioned.

- Line 2... אָבִיךָ "your father"
- Line 2... וְאֶפְשָׁר לִי לְהַצִּיגְךָ "and I will ~~show~~ ^{make} you"
- Line 3... שְׁמֶךָ "your name"
