

לֹא is the negative of the jussive.

There are many combined negatives for "never", "at no time", etc. They may be learned as you experience them in the reading of a text or in the more formal vocabulary studies.

3. Ejaculatives: Hebrew has a number of expressions that just say "oh" or "wow" or something like that. I will not list them here..you will be familiar with them through reading.
4. The conditioners:

In Lesson 10 we will talk of the conditional clauses in Hebrew but the main conditional particles are:

כִּי "if" "when"

אֲשֶׁר "if" "since"

אִם "if"

אִם־לֹא "if not"

5. Finally...remember there are many other small points in Hebrew...interesting linguistic figures, etc., and most of them will need to wait for another time.

כְּדֵּי "in order that"

לְפָנָיו "before" (generally position)

אֲשֶׁר "because", etc.

אַחֲרָי "after, behind"

כִּי־מְאֹד "very"
